**2019 SWIMMING CARNIVAL – PENINSULA LEISURE CENTRE
MONDAY 25th FEBRUARY 2019**

Dear Parents/Carers

The annual school swimming carnival will be held at the Peninsula Leisure Centre Woy Woy on **Monday 25th February 2019** for all children in years 3 -6 and those children in year 2 turning 8 in 2019 and who can swim 50m. **There will be NO unstructured swimming activities or novelty events. Students who are not entered in events will not be attending the carnival.** Children will return to school in time for afternoon buses.

Entries for the events are online at the following link <https://form.jotform.co/80381810377861> and will close on Monday 18th February at 7pm. A paper copy of the entry form can be collected from the front office if you are unable to access the internet. **There will strictly be no entries or permission notes accepted after this date.**

- Children should arrive at school at the normal time where the roll will be marked and will then travel to the pool by bus.
- All primary children, who are able to swim 50m and have entered an event are expected to attend. Supervision will be provided at school for children not attending.
- Any student absent on the day is expected to provide a note explaining their absence.
- Cost to students to enter the pool and bus fare is \$9.00. Spectators Pool entry is \$3.60
- Children should bring lunches, snacks and drinks (plenty of water, but no glass bottles please). Please note that the canteen at the pool is unavailable to students.
- Students may dress appropriately in house colours or school uniform.
PICKETT: purple DAVIS: blue DUNLOP: gold PIPER: red
- Valuables such as jewellery, watches, phones etc should be left at home and all clothing and towels should be labelled. Please bring a spare bag for wet clothes and towels.
- Children competing in the open 100m Freestyle event will need to be at school, on time to be on the first bus that leaves school.
- Individual medley is not included in our program. To apply for entry for this event at district level, your swim coach must time an IM and provide a letter to Miss Boden stating your time ASAP. Qualifying times for Junior IM (8, 9 and 10year olds) is 3:40:00 and Senior IM (11, 12 and 13 year olds is 3:20:00).
- Please indicate on the permission note if your child is returning to school on the bus. If they are not, please indicate who they will be leaving the carnival with.
- Please complete **all** sections of the permission note for each child attending. (separate note for each child)
- **There are no finals.** Ribbons will be presented at an assembly at school to students with the fastest three times in each event, **not each heat.**
