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Kincumber Public School Bring Your Own Device - 2018

Dear Parents/Carers,

In 2017 Kincumber Public School introduced a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) initiative for all Stage 3 classes. This year we will be continuing this initiative and are hopeful to move this into Stage 2 classes later in the year.

From 2018 NAPLAN will be delivered as an online test for both Years 3 and 5.

These tests will be tailored or adaptive in design, where the test automatically adapts to a student's performance and asks questions that match a student's achievement level, allowing a student to demonstrate their knowledge. This provides teachers and schools with more targeted and detailed information on students' performance on the tests. Tailored testing also provides an opportunity to broaden the scope of the assessments. Writing will continue to be on paper for both year at this stage.

Last year all students in NSW sat an online NAPLAN style test, which highlighted the implications for both skills and technology equipment in schools. Our evaluation of student performance demonstrated that students in Stage 3 that have been participating in the BYOD program had more developed technology skills than those students that have not participated.

As a public school, funds that can be specifically targeted towards technology are limited and we are relying more on parent and community support in this area to ensure our students are given every advantage. Currently we have one computer room that services all the students in the school, which does not allow us to meet the growing curricular demands for technology.

Our aim is to provide students with challenging, collaborative, everyday learning experiences that meet the needs of students' academically and prepare them for the mounting expectations for employment.

To assist parents/carers, we have provided a device specification and ask that all devices brought to school meet these standards.

Please read the school's BYOD policy (located on the schools website) along with the 'Student Agreement' (attached). It is a requirement for all students and parents/carers to sign the agreement and return it to the class teacher before any device is permitted in the classroom.

BYO Device Program 2018 Device Specifications

Students in Stage 3 can bring a laptop/notebook device for their personal use in classroom curriculum based activities. These can be either a device already owned that meets the specifications or a newly purchased device.

 - abusive
 - defamatory
 - considered bullying behaviour
- I agree to report inappropriate behaviour and material to my teacher.
- I agree to stay safe by not giving out my personal information to strangers.
- I understand that my activity on the internet is recorded and these records may be used in investigations, court proceedings or for other legal reasons.
- I acknowledge that the school cannot be held responsible for any damage to or theft of my device.
- I agree that use of my device during school activities is at the direction of the teacher.
- I have read the student responsibilities in the attached appendix and agree that I will abide by them.
