Title: Fire Alarm Emergency Response Procedure - Evacuation Staff

Safety Stations

At these stations there is:

- A telephone.
- Emergency telephone numbers.
- Internal phone list.
- Emergency flip chart.

The emergency flip charts provide a reference for any emergency. A safety station can be found at the following locations:

- 1. Lunch Room.
- 2. Reception.
- 3. Crèche.
- 4. Café.
- 5. First Aid Room.
- 6. Swim Club Room.
- 7. Health and Fitness Centre.


Emergency Assembly Areas

There are three Emergency assembly areas:

- 1. Blackwall Rd car park, Southern grass area Intermediate assembly area.
- 2. Pool Hall Lawn area (next to rainwater tanks) Intermediate assembly area.
- 3. James Browne Soccer Field Final assembly area.

Evacuation staff will move patrons to the nearest Intermediate assembly area. When instructed, patrons will be moved to final assembly area.

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Alarm Response

- 1. Alert tone sounds (Beep, Beep, Beep).
- 2. Evacuation staff continue to supervise their area telling all patrons that the alarm is being investigated and they should continue their activities.
- 3. The Duty Supervisor will work out which area set off the alarm and ask the relevant Area Warden to check problem area for fire (using radio or runner).
- 4. Area warden will arrange for problem area to be checked for fire and report back to Chief Warden.
- 5. Evacuation staff wait for further instruction from the Area Warden.

If no fire -

• Evacuation staff communicate to patrons that it was a false alarm.

In case of fire -

Note:

- After a few minutes the Alert tone (Beep, Beep) automatically changes to the Evacuate Now Tone (Whoop, Whoop)
- Wait for instruction from the Area or Chief Warden before starting to evacuate the centre.
- a. Area Wardens instruct evacuation staff to evacuate the centre.



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- b. Evacuation Staff direct patrons from their immediate area of responsibility out fire exits to assembly areas.
- c. When immediate area of responsibility has been evacuated report back to Area Warden that area is clear.
- d. Wait for further instruction from the Area Warden.
- e. Join patrons at the assembly areas when instructed by the Chief / Area Warden or Fire Brigade.

Immediate areas of responsibility for Evacuation Staff are:

These are the areas that are evacuated first. When complete refer to Area Warden for further instruction.

- **Crèche:** (Crèche Staff)
 - a. Crèche.
 - b. Toilets.
 - c. Store rooms.
 - d. Office area.
 - e. Outdoor play area.
- **Café:** (Cafe staff)
 - a. Café.
 - b. Fridge and storage areas.
- **Pool Hall:** (Lifeguards)
 - a. The water space that you are responsible for at the time.

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- **Sports Hall:** (Referees)
 - a. The activity that they are officiating.
- **Gym:** (Gym floor staff)
 - a. Weights and Cardio room.
 - b. Group Fitness room.
 - c. Store rooms.
- **Reception:** (Reception staff)
 - a. The Administration offices.
 - b. Lunch Room.
- Instructors (LTS, Squad, Aqua, Group Fitness etc)
 - a. The class you are teaching.

Take Note:

- In case of fire patrons are to leave their bags behind.
- In case of bomb threat patrons are to take their bags with them.
- The Deputy Chief Warden is only available when there is more than one Health & Fitness Team member working in the Gym. The role of the Deputy Chief Warden is to assist the Chief Warden.
- Where radios are unavailable the Chief and Area Wardens will need to communicate using runners.




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EMERGENCY EVACUATION SITE PLAN
