











#### 2018 Kincumba Shines

Dear Parents and Carers,

Kincumba Shines is a joint performance presented by the schools in the Kincumba Learning Community, which includes Kincumber High School and its primary partners: Kincumber Public School, Avoca Beach Public School, Copacabana Public School and Pretty Beach Public School.

Kincumba Shines is held every two years. These highly successful evenings are held in Education Week (Term 3, Week 3) and showcases dancers, presenters and singers from each school.

Your child has been invited to participate in 'Kincumba Shines' held at Kincumber High School on the evening of Wednesday 8 August. There will be two performances on this day: a matinee and an evening performance. All performers are expected to participate in both shows.

Kincumber Public School will be represented at Kincumba Shines by the following groups:

- The Stage Three Central Coast Dance Festival group, who will be performing "From Now On".
- The Kincumba Shines, Years 3-6 dance group, performing "Coming Home"
- School Choir

Students will walk to Kincumber High School for the matinee, which commences at 11:30am, walking back to school and returning before the end of the day. They are required to bring their costume to school and will have time to change before heading to the high school. It is recommended that students take their bag with their lunch and drink. They may wish to take a quiet activity to do while backstage (eg book to read, colouring in, pack of cards etc). No devices are allowed.

The evening show is also held at Kincumber High School and begins at 6.30pm on Wednesday 8 August. All performers will need to be at the high school by 6pm, in costume, ready to perform. The show should finish around 8pm. It is the responsibility of parents to provide transport to and from the performance, which will be held at Kincumber High School. More information on tickets and performances will follow as soon as possible.

Whilst we expect that all dancers will perform at the evening performance, we also understand that there may be unavoidable commitments which may prevent this from happening. Thank you in advance to parents who are prepared to shuffle family commitments so that dancers will be able to participate on the night. Please return the following slip as soon as possible, indicating whether or not you will be able to perform on the night, so that organisers can make adjustments to the choreography, if necessary, in the case that a dancer may not be able to attend.

We look forward to providing this opportunity for our students to perform at what should be an exciting concert.
